Stocking-stuffer...

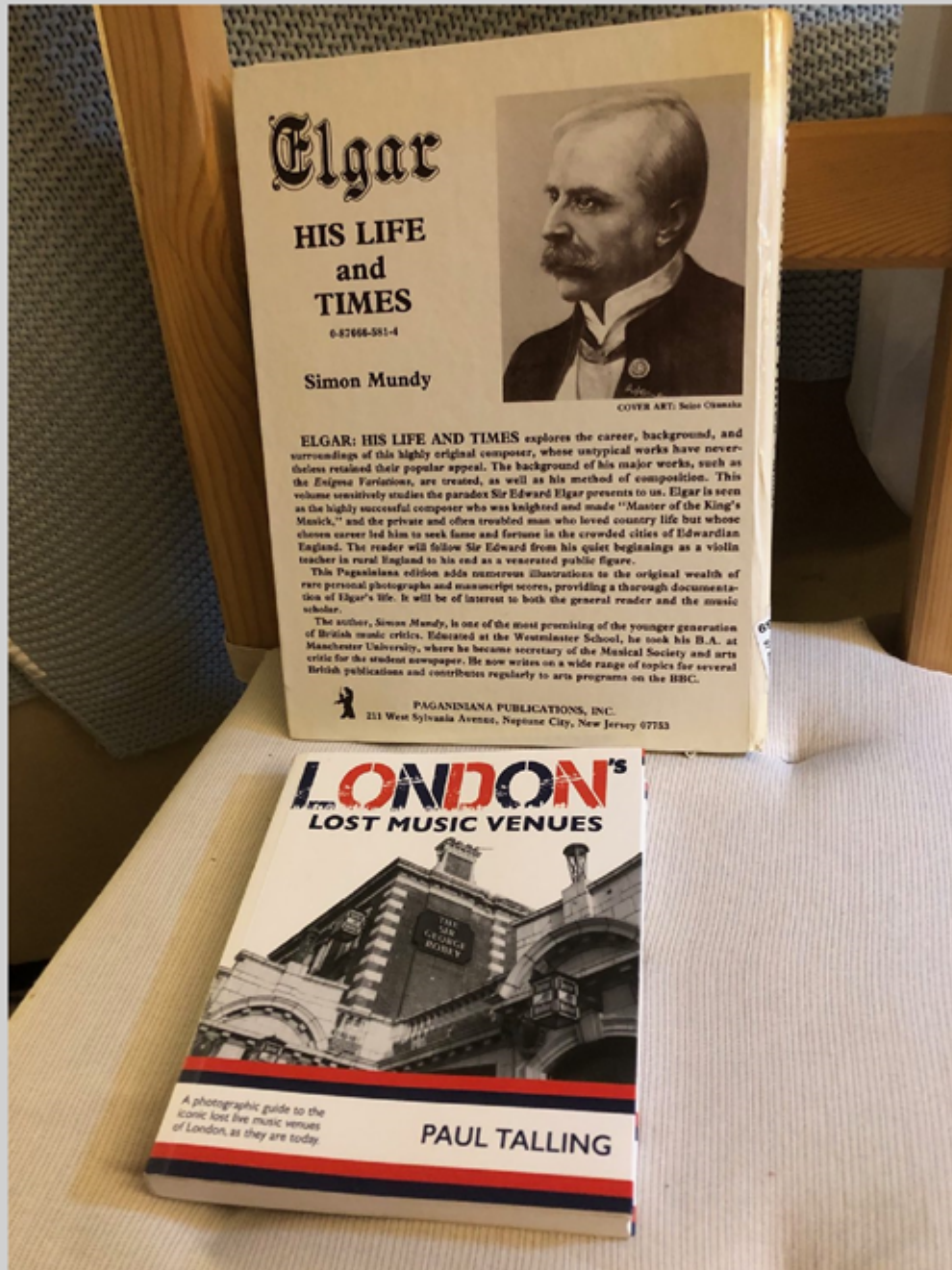

Bad Boy is on track for an October 2023 release.




